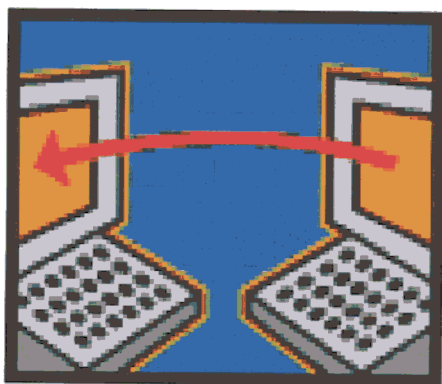


Wireless Computer Lab

WHAT IS IT?

- 5 laptop computers that are wirelessly networked

An access point to the Internet is hooked up to your network

- There is a firewall between the access point and your network

This firewall should make it very difficult for anyone to get into your network via the access point

WHY was it created:

For training the rural under-served health professional

- Consumer Health Information on the Internet
- PubMed/MEDLINE
- Other inservice sessions where hands-on is important

WHAT do you need to know?

Your network has to be DHCP (Dynamic Host Configuration Protocol) enabled, it could also have VLAN capabilities
